Additional information

He is an expert and very respected reconstructive microsurgeon who performed a high number of complex microsurgical procedures (more than 1300) with a low rate of failures (less than 1%). He is very well known for the use and evolution of the PAP flap for Breast Reconstruction in Europe. His research interest is focussed on development of new technologies in reconstructive microsurgery and implementation of RCT in surgery. He is routinely invited to International Meetings and many plastic surgeons requested to spend time with him to learn how to perform efficiently reconstructive microsurgical procedures (16 fellows to date). During his 12 years of experience in the UK, he became Associate Professor and Head of Anatomy and Plastic Surgery at the University of East Anglia in Norwich where he developed a teaching courses programme on fresh cadavers. In December 2016, with a Direct Call procedure, he moved to the University of Cagliari. He became Full Professor, Head of the Medical School, President of the Internationalization Commission at the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Cagliari and he opened the Plastic Surgery and Microsurgery Unit at the Azienda Ospedaliero-Universitaria of Cagliari. In 2019, in collaboration with the University of Sassari, he contributed to open the Specialty Training Programme in Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery in Sardinia (7 specialty training doctors per year). He routinely performs surgical private practice in the University Hospital of Cagliari (as a Director of Complex Unit he can practice only under an Intramoenia contract). He is one of the few surgeons who attracts patients who live outside the region of Sardinia. He is listed for the National Scientific Qualification Commissioners, in the 2021 call, for 06/E2, MED 19.
